Monthly News

DECEMBER 2019

The genealogy presented in Matthew 1:1-16 houses the names of five women. These women had checkered pasts. In verse 3, Tamar was a Canaanite woman who played the role of a prostitute with her father-in-law, Judah (Gen. 38). Rahab was a Canaanite prostitute who helped Joshua's spies to escape from Jericho (Josh. 2). Ruth was a sexually aggressive widow from Moab (Ruth 2-4). The wife of Uriah, Bathsheba, was David's accomplice in adultery (2 Sam. 11-12). Mary, the mother of Jesus, was suspected of premarital unfaithfulness. Each woman was shrouded in suspicions of sexual sin.

God used these five women who were broken. He ascribed to them the extraordi-

nary privilege and honor of being included in a lineage account that was almost always male in cultural practice. He forever remembered them in history as the ancestors of Jesus' proof of Messianic roots.

This is a reminder to us of how special Christmas should be. We all have checkered pasts (some of us with checkered presents). None of this is out of God's perspective, none is too much for God to utilize for good, and none is too much for Jesus to atone for. Let's not be thankful for family, presents, homes, church buildings, friends, spouses, children, or Christmas services. We have the rest of the year to be thankful for such things. When we consider Christ in this light, let's just be thankful for him and him alone.
